The awards honor those people or organizations that exemplify the highest standards of service or have made outstanding contributions to the state's air transportation system and the people they serve.

ELIGIBILITY: Any individual or organization may be nominated as long as they meet the criteria contained herein.

AWARDS PRESENTATION

Winners will be notified in advance of the actual presentation ceremony. The 2009 Aviation Awards are scheduled to be presented at the awards luncheon on Thursday, October 8, 2009, in conjunction with the 29th Annual Pennsylvania Aviation Conference in Pittsburgh.

AWARD CATEGORIES

ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

(INDIVIDUALS ONLY)

The Council's top award is presented to an individual who has demonstrated significant and positive contributions to aviation.

GOLDEN WINDSOCK AWARD

(INDIVIDUALS ONLY)

This award is presented to a non-managerial individual from any sector of the aviation industry who has provided a high level of service.

EDUCATION AWARD

(INDIVIDUALS ONLY)

This award is presented to an individual who is involved in activities or programs which promote aviation to students in age groups K-12. This includes activities or programs in the education system or extra curricular activities. This individual should have demonstrated and performed an outstanding job in furthering aviation education.

VOLUNTEER SERVICE AWARD

(INDIVIDUALS ONLY)

The **Harry M. Scarlett Memorial Award for Volunteer Service to Aviation in Pennsylvania** is presented to an individual who has dedicated their time to the enhancement and furthering of aviation in Pennsylvania. Co-sponsored by the Bucks County Airport Authority.

NEWS MEDIA AWARD

(INDIVIDUALS ONLY)

This award is presented to an individual from the news media who has provided outstanding coverage in support of the aviation industry via newspaper, television, or radio.

FIXED-BASE OPERATOR SERVICE AWARD

(ORGANIZATIONS ONLY)

This award is presented to a fixed-base operator whose firm is dedicated to maintaining outstanding customer service.

AIRPORT SERVICE AWARD

(ORGANIZATIONS ONLY)

This award is presented to an airport operator whose airport is dedicated to maintaining outstanding customer service.
