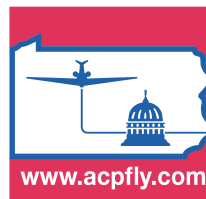

PHOTO: The new AIRBUS A380 airliner will be the world's largest commercial aircraft when it takes to the skies in late 2007. The aircraft is scheduled to operate from seven airports in North America. The AIRBUS A380 is the world's first true double-decker jetliner. It is designed to carry 555 passengers in a regular-density seat configuration, or 800 passengers in a high-density seat configuration, for a distance of 8,000 nautical miles. The maximum takeoff weight of the aircraft will be 1,300,000 lbs.
