PHOTO: The Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner (pictured) will be capable of carrying 219-250 passengers on routes of 8,200 nautical miles. The 787-9 model will carry 250-290 passengers up to 8,500 nautical miles (9,775 statute miles). The Dreamliner will be able to fly two complete, non-stop round trips between New York City and Los Angeles.

The airplane will use 20% less fuel for comparable missions than today's similarly-sized airplanes. The first deliveries of the Boeing 787 are scheduled for the first quarter of 2010.
